INSTRUCTIONS For ALL TYPES OF GRANTS

1. Complete and sign the 2010 Independent Summer Research Application Cover Sheet
2. Include a two-page description of the proposed research project that includes in the following order:
 - the project description and overall objective
 - the scholarly significance
 - the methodology/critical approach to be used
 - your previous preparation to conduct the proposed research
 - the expected outcomes
 - the relationship of the proposed research to your short and long-term goals (e.g. senior thesis, plans for graduate study).
 - include a detailed budget **if** requesting funding for supplies, travel, etc.
3. Include a signed letter of recommendation from a Pomona College faculty member who has agreed to serve as your project mentor. If your project mentor is not a Pomona College Professor please include a letter of recommendation from the project mentor as well as a letter of recommendation from a Pomona faculty member. This letter should evaluate the merits of the research proposal and your qualifications to conduct the proposed research.

ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS For SPECIALIZED GRANTS

1. **Craddock McVicar Grant applications must include** an explanation of how the teaching participation requirement will be satisfied.
2. **Rosehill applicants must live in Southern California and meet specific discipline requirements.**
3. **Schulz Environmental Studies Award applications must include** a description of plans for continued research and an explanation of how the teaching participation requirement will be satisfied.
4. **Stonehill Media Studies Grant applications must include** a detailed budget.
