Sophomore Year Checklist

- ⇒ Declare your major.
- ⇒ Continue to be involved in clubs and organizations.
- ⇒ Be sure you have registered on Route 47 www.pomona.edu/cdo/route47 to access the many resources, features and opportunities available on the CDO's online career information, posting and on-campus recruiting system.
- ⇒ Do an internship in the fall or spring semester through the Pomona College Internship Program (PCIP). Prepare for and investigate summer internships early.
- ⇒ Visit the CDO Web for Students www.pomona.edu/cdo/students and review the Resume Guide www.pomona.edu/cdo/students/resumeguide, CDO Online Resources www.pomona.edu/cdo/resources/ and other sections.
- ⇒ Visit the Study Abroad Office to look into junior year abroad options.
- ⇒ Identify skills that you want to improve (e.g., writing, presentation, artistic, computer, etc.).
- ⇒ Start to talk with alumni through the Sagehen Career Connection.
- ⇒ Update your resume.
- ⇒ Start your summer job or internship search now.
- ⇒ Explore fellowship opportunities.
- ⇒ Challenge yourself by trying new courses or exploring different fields.
- ⇒ Visit the CDO more often and talk with the staff; read the emails and CDO Weekly from the CDO.
- ⇒ Attend CDO events that bring alumni to campus or go on a Real World trip to an organization in the Los Angeles area.
- ⇒ Get a reference from your summer employer before you begin your junior year.
- ⇒ Spend several afternoons in the CDO library and explore the opportunities.
- ⇒ Attend the various career fairs and forums hosted by the 5-Cs.
